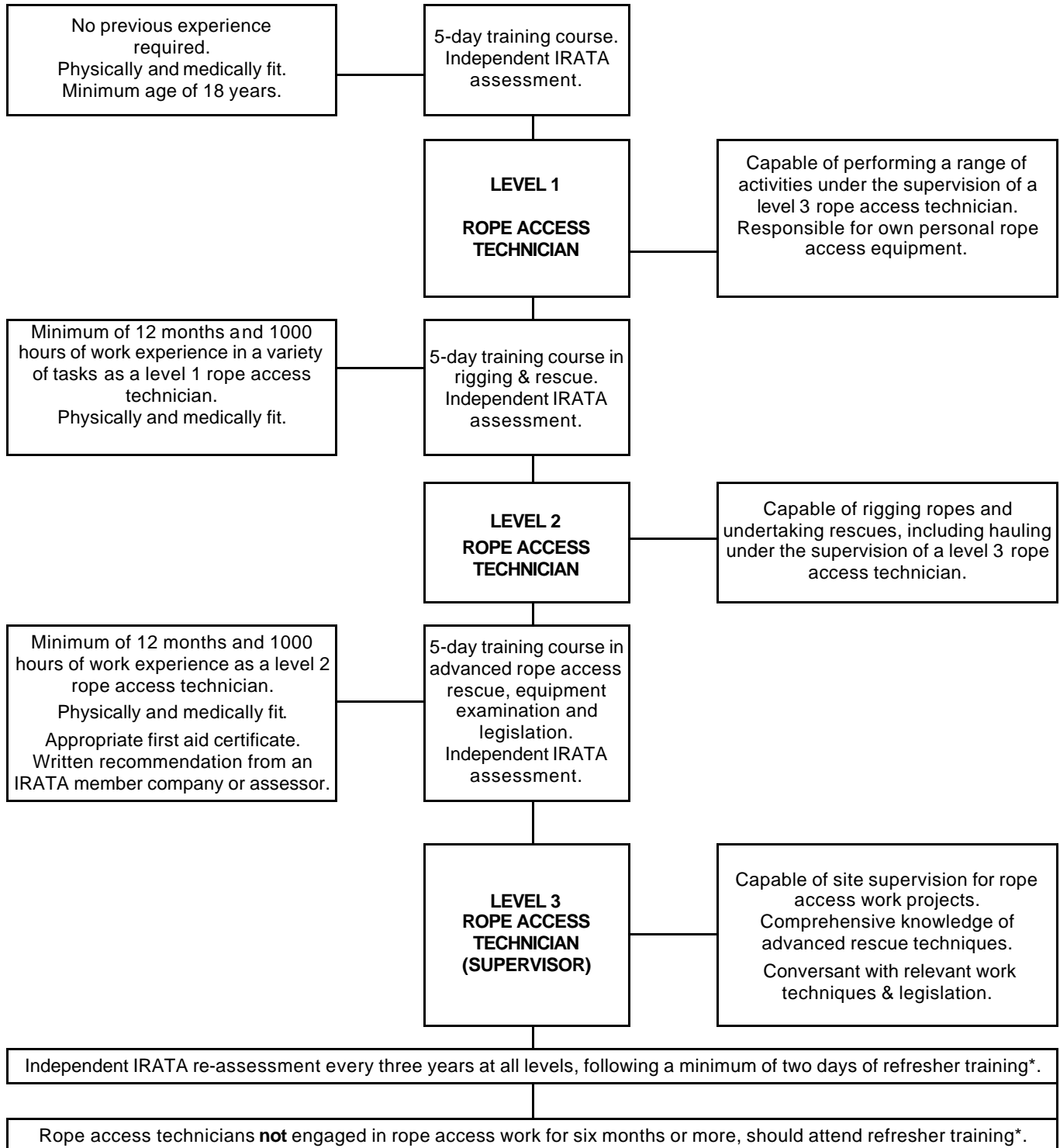


IRATA TRAINING SCHEME FLOWCHART

See IRATA *General requirements* for the detailed syllabus, requirements for levels 1, 2 and 3 rope access technicians, and principal contra-indications to working at a height and other relevant information.



*Any level 2 or 3 rope access technician undertaking re-assessment after the expiry of the current assessment would require four days of training instead of the two days. Any level 2 or level 3 rope access technician undertaking re-assessment in excess of six months after the expiry of the current assessment will revert to a lower level.

Each IRATA member company should ensure employees hold valid assessments.
